

The Chef Rey Scholarship

Culinary

\$2,000 will be awarded to three Art Institute of Houston Culinary Program students per year for three years, based on the criteria outlined below. Recipients will be chosen by the sponsor of the scholarship, Alumnus and Executive Chef of the Houston Rockets, Reynold Darthard.

Terms of Scholarship:

- Students must be enrolled full-time in a Culinary program at The Art Institute of Houston.
- Complete a 250 to 300-word essay describing financial need; what you want to achieve after graduation; reason for requesting the award etc.
- Students must have maintained an average of at least 15 hours per week of employment in a food service establishment (kitchen production) for the entire period of enrollment at The Art Institute of Houston. The Chef at the student's place of employment must complete a monthly form verifying that employment for the preceding month continues to meet the above requirement.
- Must complete the standard scholarship application and written essay.
- Students who receive scholarships will be in good academic standing with cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
