Students should create an account for free on the PSYCAS web site <https://psycas.liaisoncas.com>. Creating an account is free. However, there is a \$50 fee to PSYCAS for the first application. If a student is applying to other programs utilizing PSYCAS for the admissions process, an additional \$35 fee is charged for each additional application.

The current STRF charge is \$0.00

The STRF rate is subject to change based upon the balance in the STRF account. Statute requires the Bureau begin collecting if the balance falls below \$20 million (\$20,000,000.00) and caps the account at \$25 million (\$25,000,000.00). Please see the office of admissions for questions regarding the assessment of the STRF fee. Because this institution participates in the STRF, students who are otherwise eligible are protected by STRF regardless of whether the fee is assessed. STRF fees are currently a one-time non-refundable charge of \$0.00 per \$1,000 of institutional charges, rounded to the nearest thousand dollars; but this amount is subject to change.

The State of California established the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) to relieve or mitigate economic loss suffered by a student in an educational program at a qualifying institution, who is or was a California resident while enrolled, or was enrolled in a residency program, if the student enrolled in the institution, prepaid tuition, and suffered an economic loss.

Unless relieved of the obligation to do so, you must pay the state-imposed assessment for the Fund STRF, or it must be paid on your behalf, if you are a student in an educational program, who is a California resident, or are enrolled in a residency program, and prepay all or part of your tuition.

You are not eligible for protection from the STRF and you are not required to pay the STRF assessment if you are not a California resident, or are not enrolled in a residency program.
