Overview

South University's Montgomery campus began serving Alabama students over 100 years ago. In 2002, the campus relocated to a 26,000 square foot, two-story building on 3.75 acres on Montgomery's growing east side. The campus is outfitted with wireless technology, a student center, medical lab, nursing lab, physical therapist assisting lab, computer lab and library with access to a variety of research databases. In 2010, the campus expanded with an 18,000-square-foot addition and began offering a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree program.

Established in 1899, South University (www.southuniversity.edu) is a private, nonprofit academic institution dedicated to providing educational opportunities for the intellectual, social and professional development of a diverse student population. South University is recognized as a 501(c)(3) entity by the Internal Revenue Service, Department of the Treasury.

The University traces its heritage to 1899, when Dr. John Draughon established Draughon's Practical Business College in Savannah, Georgia. Over the past century-plus, South University has experienced growth transforming from a two-year college into a university offering undergraduate and graduate degree programs.
